**Saddle Club Camping**

- Please register online at [tristaterodeo.org](http://tristaterodeo.org) under the tab Your Stay, Camping, Saddle Clubs.
  - You MUST register AND purchase a Camping pass.
  - First time campers must contact us for availability.
  - Cost for camping is a flat fee of \$20.00 per living unit.
  - Passes can be purchased, at the Rodeo Ticket office, as of August 6th or upon arrival at the camp ground. The purchasing window is to your left of the main windows for early purchasers.
- Placement of the Camping tag must be on the **outside** of the sleeping quarter and visible from the road or fire lane. For your safety, in the **Landfill**, you will **NOT** be able to use the gas pipes to aid in roping off your area. Fenced gas pipes are **ACTIVE**. Per DNR, you are **NOT** allowed to camp within 15 feet of any fenced off gas pipe. Showers for all campers are available on a first come, first serve basis at the Non-horse campground along Airport Rd, just north of the park. There is also a playground available at this site and in the park.

**Important Dates**

- **August 28th**, Wednesday, Roping Off opens.
- Availability is in the Landfill only. There is NO roping off prior to the date above.
- **August 29th**, Thursday, move in day.
- **August 30th**, Friday, Port-a -Pots should be available.
- **August 31st**, Water will be available.
- **September 1st**, Monday, Ice Sales begin.
- **September 8th**, Sunday, Departure of EVERYTHING no later than 5:00 P.M.

**Fire Lanes**

- All fire lanes must be kept open, for your safety, for emergency vehicles. No camping or parking is allowed.

Please read the rules and abide by them (Changes made). Safety is our first concern for everyone.
